RATIONALISATION OF EXTERNAL COMMERCIAL BORROWINGS

Is this outsourcing of NPAs.

The Reserve Bank of India ("RBI") with another surprise has relaxed the governing provisions related to External Commercial Borrowings (ECB). In a recently issued circular RBI has eased the ease the borrowings norms, where for the first time RBI has permitted Indian entities to avail ECB in order to meet the working capital requirements subject to the compliance of Minimum Average Maturity Period (MAMP). Even NBFCs are also permitted to borrow ECB for on lending to Indian entities. ECB are always termed to be an important source of foreign exchange inflow in Indian economy and entities availing ECB enjoys lower rate of interest on such borrowings.

Let us evaluate the changes in brief and come to the most important indication of the recent amendments.

ECB are permitted to be borrowed by all the Indian entities who are eligible to receive foreign direct investments. Under the FDI Policy issued in the year 2016 (as amended from time to time) a blanket approval has been given to the Indian entities to receive FDI. However there are few sectors where FDI related performance linked conditions and sectoral caps have been specified (Like Single brand retail trading, etc.). In addition to this, LLPs are permitted to receive FDI only when they are operating in those sectors where 100% FDI is permitted in automatic route, and without any performance linked conditions. Hence ECB in LLP and other entities operating in certain sectors seems to be prohibited.

The All in cost ceiling restriction for ECB (Benchmark rate + 450 bps) which includes interest and other cost to be paid by Indian companies to foreign lender by availing ECB can be said to be one of the major roadblocker for Private Equity players as they are not allowed to have return exceeding the All in cost rate. However ECB still holds to be preferred choice for

Indian entities due to comparative lower rate of interest

In the erstwhile regime the ECB borrowing was bifurcated in 3 tracks whereas in the revised one, the govt. has rationalize the structure only under 2 segments i.e. borrowings under INR and Freely convertible foreign Currency (FCY). The relaxation have also been provided under the transfer of ECB borrowings from one FCY to another FCY however transfer of ECB in INR to FCY is still a prohibition.

In the circular, issued on July 30, 2019, one of the important relaxation that have been given by the RBI in the ECB regime is enabling the lender banks to sell through assignment the NPA or SMA-2 accounts to the eligible ECB lenders. For clear understanding its better to read the provision verbatim:

"It has been decided to permit eligible corporate borrowers to avail ECB for repayment of Rupee loans availed domestically for capital expenditure in manufacturing and infrastructure sector if classified as SMA-2 or NPA, under any one time settlement with lenders. Lender banks are also permitted to sell, through assignment, such loans to eligible ECB lenders, except foreign branches/ overseas subsidiaries of Indian banks, provided, the resultant external commercial borrowing complies with all-incost, minimum average maturity period and other relevant norms of the ECB framework."

Let us evaluate the every part of the above regulations in detail:

"Lender banks"- The Banks does not include non banking lender i.e. NBFCs are out of this relaxation-clarity may be required by RBI in this regard. If such view persists no benefit will accrue to ILFS, DHFL which are undergoing through beleaguered state of loans and advances and assets liability mismatch.

"Are permitted to sell through assignment"- It is

important to note that the lender bank can only sell the NPAs by way of *assignment*. The word assignment is used under the SARFAESI Act, 2002 where lender can assign NPAs to ARCs. ARCs in turn either acts as a recovery agent or securitize such NPAs by issuing the security receipts. The intent of the regulator is clear that regulator has opened the entry for foreign ARCs to have Indian Non Performing Assets.

"Provided the resultant ECB complies with All in cost requirement": There is a stringent requirement of All in cost ceiling applicable over the ECB and such restriction in case of sale of NPAs through assignment in real sense discourage the foreign ARCs / lenders. Any lender (foreign / Indian) demands 40-60% haircut while acquiring such NPAs. This quantum of haircut can never fall under the All in cost ceiling limit which is fixed marginally above the benchmark rate. RBI's further clarification in this regard would be a welcome step. A school of thought also persists that whether ARC operating in International Financial Services Center (popularly known as Gift City) can also get benefitted from the above relaxations.

Both the erstwhile and revised ECB regime has set out the negative list for usage of ECB, where one of the negative usage is investment in the real estate activities, i.e. ECB borrowings can be used as investment in the real estate activities. Real estate activities does not include construction / development of industrial parks / integrated township / SEZ, purchase/long term leasing of industrial land as part of new project/modernisation of expansion of existing units or any activity under 'infrastructure sector' definition. Thus NPAs only in the above sectors can be outsourced to foreign lenders / ARCs.

The problem of NPAs has always remained a matter of political debate among Indian political parties. Many economic pandits have predicted that problem may persist if banks (especially PSUs) are not equipped with the latest functionality and loan disbursement process. Even IBCs are also failing in providing the desired results. In light of the above problems the move as taken by RBI is a welcome step, as the step has been taken to reduce the NPA burden over the Indian Economy, however restriction like All in cost, awareness for Indian assets etc. are some of the key challenges that are required to be overcomed in near future.






